Plasse Road and West Lake Road

November 1

(closed at the State Highway)

December 1

Kit Carson Road and Kit Carson Way (closed at the State Highway)

Bear River Road and Pardoes Road

December 1

(closed at the spillway)

Little Bear Road and Tragedy Springs Road

When snow makes them impassable

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County will not conduct snow removal operations on the above listed roads after November 1 of each year;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County will endeavor to open all roads prior to Memorial Day weekend, conditions permitting. Kit Carson Road, Kit Carson Way, Little Bear Road and Tragedy Springs Road will open after the depth of snow makes them passable by automobile.
