ITEMS:

1. Discussion regarding Amador County involvement in delivery of projects in the CIP program. Jered Reinking, Sr. Civil Engineer, reported on the progress of Caltrans CIP project – the SR 88 Pine Grove Corridor Improvement Project. There are three segments to it. The re-alignment of Climax Road is the part the county would be interested in, since it involves our road. The project is ready for the PS&E phase and Public Works staff is available to perform this task. Since this is not included in ACTC's contract with Dokken Engineering, we would like to ask permission to do so. Our costs for time and materials will be reimbursed for from STIP funds through ACTC. Public Works feels this would result in cost savings for the project and will benefit all entities involved.

Recommendation: The committee recommended that Public Works draft a letter to ACTC with input from the CAO, requesting that Public Works staff be used for the PS&E phase of Climax Road re-alignment segment, for the Board chairman to sign.
