**RE: Long Term Loan from the Water Reserve Fund for Matching Share (City's Portion) of CAL OES
Approved Repair Project – Arroyo Ditch Sand Fire Damage**

Attached is documentation relating to the City of Plymouth's application for assistance from CAL OES to help fix the damages caused by the Sand Fire in July 2014. In August 2014 the City wrote a letter requesting CDA Funds. In February 2015, CAL OES held an applicant's briefing in Plymouth. Concurrently the City put in an application requesting a Directors Concurrence and disaster relief funding for the project. Shortly thereafter, the City's Project Application funding request was approved.

Background: CAL OES sent out an investigator, Jim Morales, immediately after the fire and a limited site review was made at that time. Approximately six weeks later, the City did an extensive investigation along the burned out area and paid out of pocket for a preliminary engineering estimate of damages. This estimate was approximately \$2,200,000. Damages were heaviest by the Middle Fork Diversion Dam and extended down nine miles to Bell Rd. Additionally, a significant amount of tree removal is anticipated along the entire burned out section to prevent further damage to the Ditch in the future as well as for the safety of ditch personnel working in this area. In April of 2015 CAL OES sent out an investigator to verify the extent of damage and the engineering estimates. In August 2015 The Damage Survey Report (DSR) was released to the City. Most of the estimates were authenticated, but CAL OES reduced the amount of tree removal down to that area where repair work was to be completed and disallowed all additional tree removal which put their preliminary damage allowance at \$911,313. CAL OES also stipulated a 25% matching share for the City which initially we were told would be waived. Subsequent to this the City responded to the DSR challenging the limitation on tree removal as a safety issue under OSHA Guidelines and again, as a disadvantaged community, requested a waiver of the 25% matching requirement. CAL OES responded to the limitation on tree removal, by stating that aspect may be revisited when final engineering is complete and bids for the work have been received. The request for abatement of the matching requirement went unanswered and subsequent calls to various levels of management were unproductive.


At this time it is important for the City to move forward and be ready to start work in the spring. The minimum matching requirement at the preliminary damage allowance is approximately \$227,000 for the City. If the covered costs increase, and CAL OES agrees to some additional tree removal, that amount will increase as well by a factor of 25% of the increase in value. It's possible the City's share could be as

high as \$300,000-\$400,000 in the end. We will continue to request assistance from CALOES on the matching requirement until we get a definitive answer. They have now moved on to the two new fire disasters which have just occurred, and we are told the chance of a different outcome is very slim.

Request: The City wishes to request a loan from the County of Amador's Water Reserve Fund. The Arroyo Ditch is an important resource for the County as a whole and the Pre-1914 water rights could wind up in jeopardy if the City is unable to continue diverting water. As a small disadvantaged community, with extremely high water rates, the City requests and extended repayment period, which may be accelerated in the event the City is able to develop a consumptive use model and get some funding from the Prop 1B Bonds being issued over the next 10 years. The City is currently working on a couple different avenues to develop additional beneficial and consumptive uses for the Arroyo Ditch water as well. Both of which may help bring in some cash flow for retiring the debt.

A considerable amount of background information is included which supports the process to date. If you have any questions or require additional information, I would be glad to address your concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, does hereby recognize as follows:

1. That the City and County hereby agree to the allocation of Penal Code §7005 et seq. funding as follows: County of Amador - \$125,000; City of Ione \$508,600.

2. The County intends to use the funding allocated to it for one or more of the following activities:
 - New upgraded control panel for the Amador County Jail
 - Other Capital Infrastructure Improvements at the Amador County Jail
3. Your advocacy is needed to help protect the State Health Insurance Assistance Program otherwise known as HICAP (Health Insurance Counseling and Advocacy Program) in California. HICAPs educate and help beneficiaries to navigate a complex Medicare program. It assists clients to make informed decisions from among 25 prescription drug plans, Medicare Advantage plan and Medicare Supplements. They can improve access to quality care and save money. HICAPs also provide assistance with fraud and abuse issues, billing problems, appeal rights, and enrollment in low-income protection programs.

In July, Medicare advocates were shocked and outraged that the Senate Appropriations Committee proposed a 42% cut in funding for the Medicare State Health Insurance Assistance Programs (SHIPS), from 52 million to \$30 million. Now congressional leaders are deciding whether to retain this cut.

The funding cut comes at a time when 10,000 Americans are becoming Medicare eligible each day and SHIP services are needed more than ever. A reduction of this magnitude would significantly erode the SHIP national network of unbiased, personalized Medicare benefits information counseling to older adults, people with disabilities, and their families.

Your local HICAP program covering Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, Mariposa and Tuolumne Counties has assisted 2,606 clients and saved them a total of \$1,335,552.87 in FY 2014-15. The savings assisted clients with lowering their monthly premiums, enrolling them in a Medicare Savings Plan, billing errors, appeals and supplemental insurance assistance.

We ask that you contact Senator Dianne Feinstein, Senator Barbara Boxer and Rep. Tom McClintock and urge them to reject the proposed cut in Medicare State Health Insurance Assistance Programs.

Dear Governor Brown,

The Amador County Board of Supervisors appreciates your Proclamation of a State of Emergency recognizing the State's four-year record drought conditions and the epidemic infestations of native bark beetles that together have caused over 22 million trees to die as estimated by the United States Forest Service.

We are well aware of the devastation to the forests to the Southeast of Amador County in Madera, Mariposa and Tuolumne Counties. We stand ready to assist our neighboring counties in the Sierras, but we are also aware that Amador County is already suffering the same effects from the drought and bark beetle with tree mortality of approximately 60,000 trees on 15,000 acres (roughly 4% of the total County land area).

We implore you to take even more action to support the removal of dead and infected trees. The State of California needs to support the timber milling and biomass industries with added incentives to assist them in the efforts to clear our forests of these trees. With mills at capacity and biomass production at risk because of insufficient compensation, these industries must be assisted in their efforts if California is to see our healthy forests return for our future generations to enjoy.

Amador County asks that you remind your Board and Commission appointees of your Proclamation and, as you communicated to USDA Secretary Tom Vilsack, that California is facing the worst epidemic of tree mortality in modern history. We see a cavalier attitude by some appointees who do not appear to share your sense of urgency. Your State of Emergency Proclamation correctly states, "WHEREAS this die-off is of such scale that it worsens wildfire risk across large regions of the State," and "WHEREAS such wildfires will release thousands of tons of greenhouse gas emissions and other harmful pollutants;" yet the California Air Resources Board fails to include wildfire emissions in its draft Short-Lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Strategy as required by Senate Bill 605. All appointees and staff in State agencies and in local government must share similar goals as they work towards a common strategy of restoring our forest health.

Amador County stands ready to work with all partners in support of dealing with the catastrophic effects of the drought and bark beetle infestation. We recognize our role in working with private land owners and with Federal and State partners and we strongly reiterate our support of your recent actions including the formation of the Tree Mortality Task Force.
