Location: On both sides of Hwy 26 (Red Corral Road) between Joyce Road and Bobbie Lane in the Pioneer area (APN 031-010-

109).

Background: This map project, consisting of the division of 65.62 acres into 4 single family residential lots was originally approved by the Board of Supervisors on February 7, 2006, with an initial expiration date of February 7, 2009. The project received the SB 1185, AB333, AB208, and AB116 gubernatorial extensions which extended the expiration date to February 7, 2016.

In February of 2016, the applicants requested a six-year local extension and received a one-year extension of time from the Planning Commission. The project is eligible for the requested five-year extension of time, which would place the expiration date at February 7, 2022.

Should future Senate Bills or Assembly Bills provide for further extensions of time, the project will be granted those automatically, if applicable.

Staff Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of the requested five-year extension of time for Tentative Parcel Map #2655. The request is not subject to CEQA.
