

NOTICE OF CURRENT PROPERTY TAXES DUE

Made Pursuant To Section 2609, Revenue and Taxation Code

Michael E. Ryan, Amador County Tax Collector, hereby announces that regular secured tax bills were mailed on or before November 1, 2017, to all property owners, at the addresses shown on the tax roll. If you own property in Amador County and do not receive a tax bill by November 9, please contact the Amador County Tax Collector's Office at 810 Court Street, Jackson, CA 95642-2132, or call (209)223-6364. **FAILURE TO RECEIVE A TAX BILL DOES NOT RELIEVE THE TAXPAYER OF THE RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE TIMELY PAYMENTS.**

The FIRST INSTALLMENT of the 2017-2018 taxes is due and payable on November 1, 2017, and will become delinquent if not paid by 5 pm on Monday, December 11, 2017; thereafter, a 10% penalty will be added. The SECOND INSTALLMENT is due and payable on February 1, 2018, and will become delinquent if not paid by 5 pm on Tuesday, April 10, 2018; thereafter, a 10% penalty and \$20 cost charge will be added. BOTH INSTALLMENTS may be paid when the first installment is due.

SUPPLEMENTAL TAX BILLS are an additional tax liability due to a reassessment of your property value and are due on the date the bill is mailed to you. Please check supplemental tax bill delinquent dates to be certain the taxes due are paid in a timely manner.

Payments may be made by mail sent to the Amador County Tax Collector, 810 Court Street, Jackson, CA 95642-2132, and must be **POSTMARKED BY THE DELINQUENT DATE** to avoid late penalties. Payments may also be made in person at the address shown above, between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm, Monday through Friday, holidays excepted. Additionally, payments may be made with a credit card over the telephone by calling 1-800-609-4599, or by visiting our office. Credit card and e-check payments may also be made over the Internet by visiting the web-sites shown on your tax bill.
