

In accordance with Section 2279 of the Agricultural Code, I hereby submit the 1979 Agricultural Crop Report.

Amador County's total gross farm crop value for 1979 is estimated to have been \$8,150,300. This represents an increase of more than 17% over 1978. Most of this increase is due to higher prices and increased yield and acreage for wine grapes.

The values contained in this report are gross values and in no way reflect the net gain to the producer. Operational and production costs increased steadily, limiting net income.

I wish to express my appreciation to the many persons who have contributed information for the preparation of this report.
