

In accordance with Section 2279 of the California Food and Agriculture Code, I am pleased to present this 1983 Crop and Livestock Report of Agricultural Production in Amador County.

Amador County's total gross farm crop value for 1983 is estimated to have been \$9,772,500 with timber bringing in an additional \$3,920,000 for a total value of \$13,692,000.

Crop values in this report are gross receipts to the growers and should not be confused with net income. For the past several years the production costs have continued to increase while the price received for agricultural commodities have remained about the same or decreased.

My sincere appreciation is expressed to the many individuals, firms, and State agencies that contributed invaluable information necessary in the compiling of this report.
