

Proclamation of a Local Emergency by Director of Emergency Services and Request of the Governor to Proclaim a State of Emergency and to Request a Presidential Declaration

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.64 of the County Code of Amador empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said county is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, subject to ratification by the Board of Supervisors within seven days and reaffirmation every 14 days thereafter until such local emergency is terminated; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Amador does hereby find:

That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within this county, caused by flood and storm; which began on the 22nd of March, 2018, and;

That these conditions are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County, and;

That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session;

That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency;

WHEREAS, it has now been found that local resources are unable to cope with the effects of said emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a local emergency now exists throughout this county; and,

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the Director of Emergency Services and the emergency organization of the county shall be those prescribed by state law, and by ordinance and resolutions of this county approved by the Board of Supervisors.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this declaration by forwarded to the Governor of California with the request that he proclaim the County of Amador to be in a state of emergency to include all eligible financial programs, including CDAA.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this proclamation be forwarded to the Director of the Governor's Office of Emergency Services.
