Mitigate a hazardous tree from damaging home and threat to street.

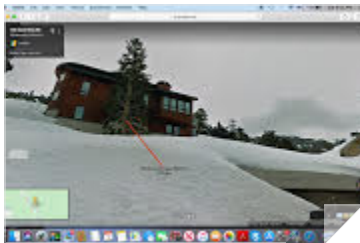
Tree will be climbed and taken down in small pieces to minimize damage to vegetation.
