Subject: Public Hearing for FY 2020 - 2021 District Budget

At the June 16, 2020, meeting of the Amador Air District Board of Directors, a draft 2020/2021 budget was reviewed and staff was directed to schedule the public hearing for today, August 18, 2020.

There has been one change in the draft 2020/2021 budget since the June 16, 2020, meeting:

Community Projects and Special Projects expense lines #54120 and 54712 have both been changed from \$75,000 to \$110,000 and, consequently, the draw from reserves will change from \$37,504 to \$107,504. The reason for the \$70,000 increase is to allow Air District staff to develop programs that will improve air quality within the community and provide the opportunity to expand those programs already in place.

#### **Recommendation:**

Conduct public hearing for the Amador Air District proposed 2020/2021 budget. After taking comments from the public approve proposed 2020/2021 budget.

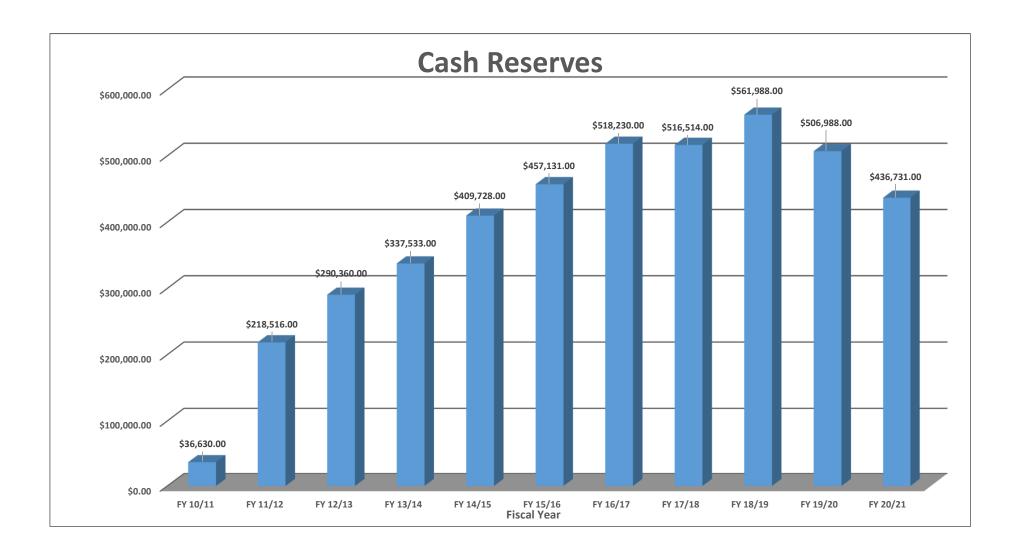

Smoke Reduction Bin Program (Pine Needles)

**Subject**: Pine Needle Bin Program

One of my goals has been to expand the existing program, making green waste bins more accessible to our residents throughout the year. This helps reduce fire hazard and nuisance smoke by providing a cost effective alternative to burning for our residents who are inclined to take advantage of the program. We plan to continue the bin located at Sutter Creek Fire Station year round for the foreseeable future; this location is well managed and highly appreciated by the public. Neighborhood bins cycle through five upcountry locations; we may consider expanding this in the future.

ACES in Pine Grove currently hosts one Saturday per month free green waste disposal. Traffic related to this event is becoming a problem for their permit, which limits the average number of vehicle per day. They would like to schedule this free day on a day that they are not open to reduce the congestion. ACES is currently open to the public Tuesday through Saturday. Keeping the event on a weekend day would be preferred by most but to move the events to Sunday would require ACES amend their Use Permit. Sunday operations would also increase our costs for personnel who would not be on hand otherwise.

To avoid added costs for the district and to help reduce constraints on ACES operations, staff have been searching for an alternate location in the area that can be secured and supervised. We may be able provide increased service at a new location.

#### **Recommendation:**

Provide staff direction on the Smoke Reduction Bin Program.

I would like to inform the Board of my plan to retire at the end of December. I thank the Board for the opportunity to serve as Air Pollution Control Officer for my brief tenure here. I would also like to thank Air District staff who are the ones doing the heavy lifting on a daily basis.

Having several months advance notice makes it possible to plan for this change to provide a smooth transition. Rather than assign the APCO duties to another department head, as has been the practice, I would recommend that the Board consider promoting existing staff to this position. I believe that the Board, as I do, have confidence in our current staff. They know the programs, know the participants involved, know the finances, and know the values and goals of this Board.

In discussing this concept with staff, it is my understanding that Matt Peterson is not interested in assuming this role but Herminia Perry would welcome the challenge. If it is the will of the Board, I would like to spend the next several months working with Mrs. Perry to prepare her for assuming the role of Air Pollution Control Officer upon my retirement.

#### Recommendation:

During the next upcoming months, allow APCO to work with Mrs. Perry to prepare her for assuming the role of Air Pollution Control Officer upon my retirement.
