Amador COVID-19 Update

Amador County, CA – Amador County Public Health confirms two new cases of COVID-19 in Amador since Friday's update. The new cases include 2 males, 1 aged 50-64 and another over 65 years of age, 1 living in Pine Grove and another in Plymouth/surrounding areas. Today, September 8, 2020, Amador County was able to move to the Red Tier on California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy tier structure. This allows additional sectors to open inside with modifications and reduced capacity.

Those sectors include:

- Restaurants may open indoors at 25% capacity
- Personal care services including nail salons may open inside with modifications
- Places of worship and cultural ceremonies including funerals may open indoors at 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
- Movie theaters may open at 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
- Gyms and fitness centers may open indoors at 10% capacity

Personal prevention measures continue to be important for Amador to move towards a less restrictive future. Avoid mixing with others outside your household. Individuals can be contagious before symptoms of COVID-19 are present. Maintain 6-foot physical distance and wear a face covering. Persons over age 65 and those with chronic health conditions that put them at higher risk for severe COVID-19 are encouraged to stay home as much as possible. Avoid unnecessary travel. Stay home if you are sick even with mild symptoms.

The no-cost COVID-19 test site in Jackson remains open. Local test results are currently received within as few as three days of the test collection. Total cases in Amador to date = 239 cases.

Total hospitalized in Amador County = 2 cases.

Total confirmed COVID-19 deaths = 15 deaths.

Total active cases = 8 cases.

Total cases released from isolation to date = 216 cases. Cases are released from isolation when they are no longer infectious.
