7. JACKSON CITY ISLANDS CLEAN UP REORGANIZATION, LAFCO PROJECT #331, RESOLUTION #2021-05 (public hearing)

Annexation of 5 small unincorporated areas/portions of parcels totaling less than 3.67 acres, to eliminate unincorporated islands within city. Includes detachment from Amador Resource Conservation District, Amador Fire Protection District

and County Service Areas 5 & 6; CEQA exempt Section 15319(b), annexation of existing facilities and lots for exempt facilities, no change anticipated in services or service demand and no possibility that the project could have a negative effect on the environment.

# 8. ADOPTION OF A SPHERE OF INFLUENCE FOR SUTTER CREEK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT; LAFCO PROJECT #323; RESOLUTION #2021-06 (public hearing)
