## **Delta Variant Circulating in Amador County**

Amador County, CA – Amador County Public Health has confirmed COVID-19 <u>variants</u> circulating in our community. Amador has now identified case clusters of the <u>Delta</u> variant. The Delta variant has been found to be more transmissible and may be more likely to cause severe disease, especially in unvaccinated people. All unvaccinated people should wear a mask indoors in public. Even if fully vaccinated, those who are at high-risk for severe disease, or who live with someone who has underlying conditions, should strongly consider wearing a mask indoors while in public as this variant is 75% more contagious.

Because vaccination is the primary protection against the COVID-19 virus, including the more contagious Delta variant, Amador Public Health is offering COVID-19 vaccine at pop-up outreach clinics. Visit the <a href="Manager-Public-Health"><u>Amador Vaccine Information website</u></a> to find a clinic near you. Homebound individuals may schedule a nurse home-visit vaccination appointment by calling Amador Public Health at (209) 223-6407.

Individuals who have only received one dose of the two-dose vaccine series do not yet have maximum protection and are encouraged to schedule their second-dose appointment. Multiple vaccination opportunities are available within Amador County. For COVID-19 testing, the OptumServe COVID-19 test site, located in the rear parking lot of the Health and Human Services building in Sutter Creek, offers testing each Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday from 7 am to 3 pm. The clinic will be open Saturday, July 3, 2021 but closed on Monday, July 5, 2021, in observance of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday. COVID-19 testing is free of charge. No appointments are necessary. Test site staff assist with on-site registration.
