


What is a Pavement Mgmt. Program?




- **A** tool to help make cost-effective decisions



































Conclusions



- Amador County has a substantial investment in road network (\$121 million)
- ♣ Network is in "at risk" condition; PCI = 57
- Existing budget (\$150 K/year) is not sufficient
 - Roads will deteriorate to 11 by 2034
 - Unfunded backlog grows to \$274 million!
 - Very poor roads grow 10 times to 78%!!

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Policy Considerations



- Ensure acceptable quality of life for residents, visitors & businesses
 - Smoother rides
 - Lower maintenance cost for vehicles
- Ensure taxpayer's investment in transportation infrastructure is protected
