Amador COVID-19 News

Amador County, CA – COVID-19 in Amador has decreased to 4 currently active cases in county residents. Active case counts include confirmed lab results and supervised antigen tests but do not include self-administered home tests. Dashboard demographics and geographic data are updated on the Amador County website: http://www.amadorgov.org/services/covid-19. As of this week, the website data table will be updated once weekly on Tuesdays. Sutter Amador Hospital currently has 1 patient hospitalized due to COVID, a resident of another county. No Amador County residents are known to be hospitalized.

This week the Health and Services Building (HHS) COVID-19 vaccine clinic schedule shifted to Tuesday mornings from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM and Friday afternoons from 1 PM to 4 PM. To schedule a COVID-19 vaccine clinic appointment visit the myturn.ca.gov website. Appointments may be scheduled for homebound individuals by calling Amador Public Health at (209) 223-6407. Retail pharmacy COVID-19 vaccination availability may be checked at vaccines.gov.

Rapid antigen testing, in addition to PCR testing, is available at the local OptumServe COVID test site. The Health and Human Services Building (HHS) test site operates on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday from 7 AM to 3 PM.
