ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF AMADOR RESCINDING THE January 3, 2022 ORDER MANDATING ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

DATE OF RESCISSION: April 8, 2022

Effective immediately, the January 3, 2022 ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF AMADOR MANDATING ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 is rescinded in full in accordance with Section 7 of that Order. Case rates are declining, more people are receiving COVID-19 vaccines and boosters, and transmission rates of COVID-19 have decreased. However, the risk of further COVID-19 variants is still unknown.

Accordingly, individuals should continue to follow guidance released by the United States Department of Health & Human Services ("HHS") including their sub-agency United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"); California Department of Public Health ("CDPH"); California Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Occupational Safety and Health, better known as "Cal/OSHA;" and California Department of Social Services ("CDSS"). The January 3, 2022 Order is rescinded in order to align with the above-mentioned authorities and guidelines.
