**ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF AMADOR RESCINDING THE
January 3, 2022 ORDER
MANDATING ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS
TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF COVID-19**

DATE OF RESCISSION: April 8, 2022

Effective immediately, the **January 3, 2022 ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF AMADOR MANDATING ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF COVID-19** is rescinded in full in accordance with Section 7 of that Order. Case rates are declining, more people are receiving COVID-19 vaccines and boosters, and transmission rates of COVID-19 have decreased. However, the risk of further COVID-19 variants is still unknown.

Accordingly, individuals should continue to follow guidance released by the United States Department of Health & Human Services ("HHS") including their sub-agency United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"); California Department of Public Health ("CDPH"); California Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Occupational Safety and Health, better known as "Cal/OSHA;" and California Department of Social Services ("CDSS"). The January 3, 2022 Order is rescinded in order to align with the above-mentioned authorities and guidelines.
