



**NOTICE OF ELECTION AND NOTICE OF
DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measure is to be voted on at the **General Election** to be held within the **County of Amador**, on Tuesday, **November 8, 2022**. The Vote Centers will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at least three days prior to the election, and 7:00 am until 8:00 pm on Election Day.

AMADOR COUNTY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT – MEASURE H

To repair and improve local schools, shall Amador County Unified School District's measure be adopted to repair old classrooms and facilities; repair/ replace leaky roofs and outdated infrastructure; replace outdated portables with permanent classrooms; and build new facilities to improve the quality of education at consolidated schools; by issuing \$64,000,000 in bonds at legal rates, levying approximately 5¢ per \$100 of assessed value, raising an estimated average \$4,300,000 annually while bonds are outstanding, with audits and citizen oversight?

To be eligible for printing and distribution as provided by law, any such arguments must be received and filed with the Amador County Elections Office no later than said date and time and must be accompanied by a Statement of Accuracy, pursuant to California Elections Code section 9600, and be signed and dated by the author(s).

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that if an argument in favor of and an argument against the measure are submitted, copies will be mailed to the respective authors in order that they may submit a rebuttal argument not to exceed two hundred fifty (250) words. Rebuttal arguments must be filed not later than 5:00 p.m. on **August 22, 2022**, and must also be accompanied by a Statement of Accuracy, signed and dated by the author(s).
