Amador COVID-19 Update

Amador County, CA – Due to the holiday on Monday, October 10, 2022, the OptumServe COVID-19 test site at the Health and Human Services building will be closed. The site will resume scheduled operations on Wednesday, October 12, 2022 from 7 AM to 3 PM. Register for no-cost testing at the <a href="https://linearchai.com/l

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) is offering another option for telehealth services to support COVID-19 treatment access in underserved areas. Anyone who tests positive, including with a home test, should contact their provider as soon as possible. If you do not have or are unable to reach your health care provider, this program provides access to a virtual telehealth visit for people who have tested positive for COVID-19 and are symptomatic so that they may be evaluated for treatment. Appointments may be scheduled online with Sesame Care or by calling 1-833-686-5051. Both OptumServe and Sesame Care services are provided at no-cost.

COVID-19 vaccine clinics, including bivalent COVID-19 boosters, continue to be offered at the Health and Human Services Building on Tuesday mornings from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM and on Thursday afternoons from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM. To schedule a vaccine appointment visit the myturn.ca.gov website or call 1-833-422-4255. Appointments are prioritized; walk-ins must arrive at least ½ hour before the clinic end time. Retail pharmacies also continue to offer COVID vaccines, check the vaccines.gov website for availability. To schedule a vaccination for homebound individuals, call Public Health at (209) 223-6407.
