The Amador County Board of Supervisors is looking for one interested to serve on the subject committee for a term of four (4) years.

Agricultural Advisory Committee: The Agricultural Advisory Committee was formed in order to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on applications for Ag zoning, proposed divisions of lands, and boundary line adjustments of Ag-zoned property, and other agricultural matters referred to them by the decision-making bodies of the County. The Committee is comprised of the County Assessor, the County Farm Advisor, the County Agricultural Commissioner, one member from the Planning Commission, various ex-officio members, and one regular and one alternate member from each Supervisorial District (these terms coincide with the Supervisor who approves the appointments for the respective Districts).

The Committee meets at least once a year, generally in September or October and additional meetings are held "as needed", but usually not more than four (4) additional meetings per year.
