#### **REGULAR AGENDA**

Update by the Amador County Health Officer, Dr. Rita Kerr on the COVID-19 situation in Amador County.

**Agriculture Department:** Presentation and Introduction of new UCANR staff members. There is a new Farm Advisor, a new Livestock Advisor, and a new Woody Biomass & Forest Products Advisor.

Ms. JoLynn Miller, Director of UC Cooperative Extension, addressed the Board and provided a presentation and introduced the new UCANR staff members.

At this time, the following individual wished to speak:

Mr. Dana Jorgensen, with state senator Marie Alvarado-Gil's office is fully supportive of having the UCCE offer as much as they can while being sensitive to the County budget. Mr. Jorgensen also reflected on how there might be a demand for sawmill facilities in Amador County and that his office is supportive and open to ideas.

Discussion and possible action relative to requested changes in the salaries of the Amador County Elected Officials.

Mr. Jim Rooney, Amador County Assessor, addressed the Board on their request for a cost of living adjustment (COLA), similar to what the management unit has previously received.

Mr. Chuck Iley, County Administrative Officer (CAO), stated the management unit received two 4% COLA's, starting in October of 2022, and the unit will receive another 4% COLA in October of 2023, which is the same amount that was given to the SEIU and law enforcement given a three year deal, which is 12% over three years at 4% per year.

Supervisor Oneto inquired on the staff memo and if the Sheriff's request of a 10% increase would be in addition to the COLA. Mr. Rooney mentioned that the Elected's received an adjustment about a year ago, that included all elected's, except the Sheriff as it was during an election year.

Lengthy discussion ensued and the following action was taken.

<u>MOTION</u>: It was moved by Supervisor Crew, seconded by Supervisor Forster, and carried 3-2, to approve and accept the COLA increase to the Elected Officials and make a 7% adjustment, to the Sheriff's salary, in addition to the COLA, to avoid the compaction issue with the Undersheriff, retroactive to January 1, 2023.

Supervisor Oneto clarified his vote by stating he was in support for the COLA increase only and was not in favor of the 7% adjustment for the Sheriff.
