ORDINANCE NO. 1553

Ordinance Re-enacting Ordinance No. 590

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador ordains as follows:

Section 1. RECITALS

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 590, adopted April 26, 1977, established open range grazing in a defined area of the eastern portion of Amador County, with that portion specified by metes and bounds in said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 590 was codified in the Amador County Code as Chapter 8.40; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1436 was adopted on May 6, 1997, amending and replacing Chapters 8.04 through Chapters 8.44 of the Amador County Code, inadvertently repealing Ordinance No. 590 which had been codified as Chapter 8.40; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors did not intend by adopting Ordinance No. 1436 to repeal or amend Chapter 8.40 and only recently was informed of the clerical error set forth in Ordinance No. 1436 inadvertently repealing Chapter 8.40; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has intended to keep Ordinance No. 590, codified as Chapter 8.40, in effect from the time of its adoption in 1977 through the present and adopts this Ordinance re-enacting said Chapter 8.40 as it was adopted in Ordinance No. 590.

Section 2. RE-ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCE 590. The Board of Supervisors hereby re-enacts said Chapter 8.40 which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
