ORDINANCE NO. 1564

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7.38 OF THE AMADOR COUNTY CODE PERTAINING TO REGULATION OF SMOKING AROUND COUNTY BUILDINGS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador ordains as follows.

Section 1. Chapter 7.38 of the Amador County Code, "Regulation of Smoking In County Facilities" is amended as follows.

Section 2. Section 7.38.020 is hereby repealed, re-adopted, and renumbered as Section 7.38.040.

Section 3. Section 7.38.020 and section 7.38.030 are hereby added to said Chapter as follows:

"7.38.020. Prohibition of smoking adjacent to doors and ventilation systems of County buildings. The smoking or holding of any lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or other device containing tobacco or similar substance within 20 feet of any entrance, exit, covered entryway, open window, or ventilation system intake appurtenant to any building or enclosed facility owned, operated, or controlled by Amador County is hereby prohibited.

7.38.030. <u>Posting of signs</u>. To aid in the public's awareness of this ordinance, but not as a necessary condition of its enforcement or validity, signs may be posted around said entrances, exits, covered entryways, open windows, and ventilation system intakes stating that smoking in the area is prohibited."

Section 4. This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published in the manner prescribed

in Government Code section 24124 and shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of

adoption.
