

ORDINANCE NO. 1625

AMENDING CHAPTER 19.84 OF THE AMADOR COUNTY CODE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF AMADOR COUNTY

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador ordains as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 19.84 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 1620, adopted as an urgency ordinance, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Chapter 19.84 is hereby added to the Amador County Code to read as follows:

“CHAPTER 19.84

MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES PROHIBITED

19.84.010 Medical Marijuana Dispensaries Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to locate or operate a medical marijuana dispensary in any zoning district in the unincorporated area of Amador County.

19.84.020 Violations; Penalty.

The penalty for any violation of this Chapter shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of \$500 and/or six months imprisonment.”

Section 4.


