

ORDINANCE NO. 1669

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 7.42.050 AND 7.42.060 OF THE AMADOR COUNTY CODE AND ADDING A NEW SECTIONS 7.42.050 AND 7.42.060 TO THE AMADOR COUNTY CODE RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT FEES.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 7.42.050 and 7.42.060 of the Amador County Code are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2. New Sections 7.42.050 and 7.42.060 are hereby added to the Amador County Code which shall read as follows:
