

ORDINANCE NO. 1687

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7.60.020 of Chapter 7.60 of the Amador County Code shall be deleted and the following revised Section 7.60.020 shall be adopted and substituted in place of the deleted section:

“7.60.020 Purpose.

The express purpose for which the benefit assessment is levied is to establish a stable source of supplementary funds to obtain, furnish, operate and maintain fire suppression equipment and to provide structural fire suppression services in the Amador fire protection district (“district” hereinafter) whether or not fire suppression services are actually used by those obligated to pay the benefit assessment. The district is composed of the unincorporated area of the county excluding said area covered by the Lockwood fire protection district, Kirkwood public utilities district, Sutter Creek fire protection district, and the Jackson Valley fire protection district (“benefit assessment area” hereinafter).”


SECTION 2. This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published within fifteen days after the date hereof in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Amador, State of California, and shall become effective thirty days after the date hereof.


