

ORDINANCE NO. 1776

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.08 REGARDING SPEED LIMITS BY
CHANGING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED FOR CAMANCHE, CLIMAX, CLINTON,
CURRAN, RIDGE AND SHENANDOAH ROAD SPEED LIMITS.**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador does ordain as follows:

SECTION I. Recitals of Facts and Determinations in Support of Ordinance.

A. The California Vehicle Code Section 22358 provides that whenever the County determines upon the basis of an engineering and traffic survey that the current speed limit is more than is reasonable or safe upon any portion of any street other than a state highway, the County may by ordinance determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit which is found most appropriate to facilitate the orderly movement of traffic and that is reasonable and safe. The declared prima facie limit shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon the roadway section.

B. The County Public Works Agency conducted updated engineering and traffic surveys on various County roads to gather information for determining the reasonable speed limits. The results of the speed surveys recommend changes to Camanche, Climax, Clinton, Curran, Ridge and Shenandoah roads speed limits;

with respect to Camanche Road, from Lake Parking Lot Post Mile 0.00 to Camanche Parkway Post Mile 0.80 the prima facie speed limit should be changed from 25 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour.

with respect to Camanche Road, from Camanche Pkwy Post Mile 0.80 to Reservation Rd Post Mile 2.18 from 35 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour.

with respect to Climax Road, from Ridge Road Post Mile 0.00 to Highway 88 Post Mile 3.02, the prima facie speed limit should be changed from 35 miles per hour to 30 miles per hour.

with respect to Clinton Road, from Butte Mountain Road (West) Post Mile 0.53 to Irishtown Road Post Mile 8.85 the prima facie speed limit should be changed from 55 miles per hour to 50 miles per hour.

with respect to Curran Road, from Camanche Parkway Post Mile 0.00 to Camanche Rd Post Mile 4.10 the prima facie speed limit should be changed from 55 miles per hour to 45 miles per hour.

with respect to Ridge Road, from Ponderosa Way Post Mile 7.73 to Highway 88 Post Mile 8.33 the prima facie speed limit should be changed from 25 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour.

With respect to Shenandoah Road, from Fiddletown Road Post Mile 0.29 to Ostrom Road Post Mile 6.59 the prima facie speed limit should be changed from 55 miles per hour to 50 miles per hour.

SECTION II. The following Sections of Chapter 10.08 of the Amador County Code are hereby amended as follows:

10.08.040 Climax Road, County Road No. 2.

The board determines and declares a prima facie speed limit of thirty miles per hour on Climax Road from Post Mile 0.00 to Post Mile 3.02.

10.08.050 Ridge Road, County Road No. 22.

The board determines and declares a prima facie speed limit of:

1. Forty-five miles per hour on Ridge Road from one-half mile west of the New York Ranch Road intersection to one-half mile east of such intersection, for a total of one and eight tenths miles in length (PM 3.0 to PM 4.85); and
2. Thirty-five miles per hour on Ridge Road from Post Mile 7.73 to Post Mile 8.33.

10.08.370 Camanche Road, County Road No. 90.

The board determines and declares a prima facie speed limit of:

1. Thirty-five miles per hour on Camanche Road from Post Mile 0.00 to Post Mile 0.80; and
2. Forty-five miles per hour on Camanche Road from Post Mile 0.80 to Post Mile 2.18.

10.08.380 Clinton Road, County Road No. 13.

The board determines and declares a prima facie speed limit of fifty miles per hour on Clinton Road from Post Mile 0.53 to Post Mile 8.85.

10.08.390 Curran Road, County Road No. 88.

The board determines and declares a prima facie speed limit of forty-five miles per hour on Curran Road from Post Mile 0.00 to Post Mile 4.10.

10.08.390 Shenandoah Road, County Road No. 55.

The board determines and declares a prima facie speed limit of fifty miles per hour on Shenandoah Road from Post Mile 0.29 to Post Mile 6.59.

SECTION III. Except as set forth above, the remainder of Chapter 10.08 is unaffected by this ordinance and is deemed reenacted without amendment.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be published within fifteen days after the date hereof in a

newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Amador, State of California, and shall become effective thirty days after the date hereof.

The foregoing ordinance was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 10th day of July 2018, by the following vote:
