

ORDINANCE NO. 1748

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE FOLLOWING CHAPTERS OF AMADOR COUNTY CODE:

CHAPTER 14.02 – RELATING TO WATER SERVICE

CHAPTER 14.04 - RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR SEWER AND WATER INSTALLATIONS

CHAPTER 14.08 – RELATING TO WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS

CHAPTER 14.16 – RELATING TO SANITARY SEWER INSTALLATIONS

CHAPTER 14.20 – RELATING TO SERVICE AREA SEWER REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 14.22 – RELATING TO CSA3 SEWER REGULATIONS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14.02 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Chapter 14.04 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Chapter 14.08 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 4. Chapter 14.16 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 5. Chapter 14.20 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 6. Chapter 14.22 of the Amador County Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 7. This ordinance was introduced and the title thereof read at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors on February 24, 2015 and on February 24, 2015 further reading was waived by the unanimous vote of the Supervisors present.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on and after thirty (30) days from the date of its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the date of its passage it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same, said publication to be made in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Amador.
