RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMADOR COUNTY'S) RESOLUTION NO. 23-080
PARTICIPATION IN THE SAFE STREETS AND)
ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT)

WHEREAS, as part of the new Federal Transportation Bill, Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), there is over \$1,000,000,000.00 of roadway safety funding available in the form of Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants. To be an eligible applicant for project implementation with this funding, a county must have an eligible Action Plan in place; and

WHEREAS, Amador County plans to apply for a SS4A grant to develop a county-wide eligible Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Amador County Board of Supervisors will commit to achieving significant declines in roadway fatalities and serious injuries in Amador County; and

WHEREAS, the Amador County Board of Supervisors recognizes the Action Plan will assist the Public Works Department in achieving the goal of a dramatic decrease in roadway fatalities and serious injuries by 2030 and zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries by the year 2050; and

WHEREAS, the Amador County Board of Supervisors desires to participate in a SS4A grant to develop and receive an eligible Action Plan for Amador County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief Administrative Officer or Director of General Services or their staff directed to do so be authorized on behalf of the Amador County Board of Supervisors to execute and submit the grant documents for the purposes of efficient administration.
