WHEREAS, The Argonaut High School football team, the Argonaut Mustangs, and their coach, Rick Davis, are recognized for their historic win of the CIF Division 6-AA State Championship Bowl Game; and

WHEREAS, the Argonaut Mustangs achieved such excellence on December 11, 2021, when they defeated the Quartz Hill Royals at Dan Barnett Field in Jackson, California; and

WHEREAS, with everlasting support from their coach Rick Davis and his record of five MLL Titles, two Section Titles and four undefeated MLL seasons, it demonstrates how the dynamic brotherhood of the Mustangs gained 467 rushing yards and scored seven touchdowns securing a 47-14 victory, historically claiming the first state football title for Argonaut High School and in Amador County; and

WHEREAS, the triumphant Argonaut Mustangs earned a rightful place at the top of their sport for their impressive 2021 season and also for the example that they set for future generations of athletes in Amador County; and
