WHEREAS, AB 1103, which was signed by the Governor in October of 2021 and codified as California Food and Agricultural Code section 2350, establishes a county livestock pass program (Livestock Pass) for the purpose of granting access to a Livestock Pass-holder's ranch property during or following a natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, possession of a Livestock Pass during a wildfire or similar disaster allows the individual access to areas that may otherwise be restricted to the public so that the Livestock Passholder can protect or care for livestock (such as feeding, watering, providing medical treatment, and/or transporting livestock); and

WHEREAS, Food and Agricultural Code section 2350 provides that the agricultural commissioner, or other designee, may only establish a livestock pass program within that county after the approval of the Board of Supervisors.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador that:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves and authorizes the County Agricultural Commissioner to establish within the county a livestock pass program pursuant to Food and Agricultural Code section 2350.
