PROGRAM PURSUANT TO FOOD AND )  
AGRICULTURAL CODE SECTION 2350 )

WHEREAS, AB 1103, which was signed by the Governor in October of 2021 and codified as California Food and Agricultural Code section 2350, establishes a county livestock pass program (Livestock Pass) for the purpose of granting access to a Livestock Pass-holder's ranch property during or following a natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, possession of a Livestock Pass during a wildfire or similar disaster allows the individual access to areas that may otherwise be restricted to the public so that the Livestock Pass-holder can protect or care for livestock (such as feeding, watering, providing medical treatment, and/or transporting livestock); and

WHEREAS, Food and Agricultural Code section 2350 provides that the agricultural commissioner, or other designee, may only establish a livestock pass program within that county after the approval of the Board of Supervisors.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador that:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves and authorizes the County Agricultural Commissioner to establish within the county a livestock pass program pursuant to Food and Agricultural Code section 2350.
