WHEREAS, all Californians are urged to take action for suicide prevention and promote mental health and wellness as we strive towards zero suicides; and

WHEREAS, September 4th through 10th is recognized across the United States as Suicide Prevention Week and September is recognized as National Suicide Prevention Month, providing the opportunity to educate and engage everyone in our community to find their role in suicide prevention.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, by Amador SPEAKS, Amador County's suicide prevention coalition, and all members of the Amador County Board of Supervisors on this 13th Day of September, 2022, that the week of September 4th through 10th, 2022 be declared 'SUICIDE PREVENTION WEEK' and that the month of September be declared 'SUICIDE PREVENTION MONTH'.
