WHEREAS, Amador County General Services Administration has identified the 480i-200E Reclaimer/Stabilizer of County personal property to be declared as Surplus property, and;

WHEREAS, the County of Amador has an Agreement in place with Public Surplus an on line auction site and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has the authority to authorize the Purchasing Agent to sell the 480i-200E Reclaimer/Stabilizer, and;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California hereby declares as follows;


- 1) The property described as the 480i-200E Reclaimer/Stabilizer is deemed Surplus Property, and;
- 2) Authorizes the sale of this property at public auction by Public Surplus at a minimum reserve of \$0.00, and;
- 3) Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to sell the 480i-200E Reclaimer/Stabilizer to Asphalt Zipper at 60% of its original sale price should the 480i-200E Reclaimer/Stabilizer not sell at public auction at a minimum reserve of \$0.00 by the Purchasing Agent.
