WHEREAS, Cross Annexation to Drytown County Water District, consisting of APN 008-140-042 and 008-042-039 is proposed pursuant to LAFCO Project #332; and

WHEREAS, California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 99.01 provides for special districts and the County to negotiate an agreement for the transfer of taxes in annexing areas and The Board of Directors of Drytown County Water District adopted Resolutions 2020-04 for APN 008-042-039 and Resolution 2020-05 for APN 008-140-042 accepting the property tax share as proposed by Amador County, which does not include a share of the property tax increment for the annexation parcels.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Amador County Board of Supervisors does hereby conclude that no property taxes will be exchanged.
