WHEREAS, Senate Bill 106 was signed into law on August 12, 2001 amending Sections 9250.7 and Section 22710 of the California Vehicle Code relative to the Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Program (AVA); and

WHEREAS, the County hereby supports and approves the continuation of the \$1.00 vehicle registration fee and thereafter disbursing them as required for the abatement, removal and disposal as public nuisances of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles or parts thereof from private and public property.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County supports the continuation of the \$1.00 registration fee and also supports the extension of the program period for an additional ten years as implemented under Section 22710 (Service Authority for abatement of abandoned vehicles).
