WHEREAS, California Elections Code requires that following each federal decennial census, the Board of Supervisors shall by ordinance or resolution, adopt boundaries for all supervisorial districts of the county; and

WHEREAS, prior to considering this final map for adoption, the Board of Supervisors has held all of the public hearings required by Elections Code 21507.1

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador that:


The Board adopts and establishes the 2021 decennial supervisorial districts by adjusting the boundaries of the five Amador County supervisorial districts as depicted on "Original BA". That map shall be referred to as the Official Map, Supervisorial District Boundaries, adopted December 14, 2021. The official Supervisorial District Map shall be available to the public at the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Elections Department.
