WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that acts of brutality and misconduct by officers does not reflect the character and professionalism of the majority of this nation's 800,000 peace officers; and

WHEREAS, recent circumstances have resulted in numerous national non-violent protests as well as violent protests which have included looting, destruction of private property, and violence towards civilians and peace officers throughout the country; and


WHEREAS, the Board recognizes, respects, and supports the Constitutional right of everyone to peacefully protest against acts of police brutality and misconduct, but also likewise condemns the acts of violence and destruction committed by some engaged in these protests; and

WHEREAS, The Board recognizes the difficult and dangerous work all peace officer's in Amador County perform every day in protecting and serving our community and its residents and visitors.


THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, does hereby adopt this resolution supporting Amador County's professional, dedicated, and community minded men and women of law enforcement and their enforcement of the Rule of Law while respecting the rights of everyone they encounter.
