BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board hereby declares its intention to vacate various easements consisting of Easement "A" a Public Utility Easement to be abandoned between Lots 57 and 58, Lake Camanche Village Unit 1; Easements "B" a Pedestrian and Equestrian Trail and Public Utility Easement to be abandoned along the West line of Lot 57, Lake Camanche Village Unit 1; Easement "C" a 25' Building Set Back and Public Utility Easement to be abandoned along North side of Future Street, Lake Camanche Village Unit 1; Easements "D" abandon Street, Pedestrian and Equestrian Trails and Public Utility Easements and various Easements being abandoned over Future Street and Parcel EE, Lake Camanche Village Unit 1 for Thomas M. Kirkbride; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said vacation is proceeding pursuant to Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 8320) of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highway Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing to consider said vacation will be held at the County Administration Center, 810 Court Street, Jackson, California, on September 22, 2020, at 10:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at which time any and all interested persons may come and be heard thereon.
