ADOPTING THE 2019 CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE)

RESOLUTION NO. 20-143

WHEREAS, Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code 13869, the Amador Fire Protection District (District), for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property, duly passed and adopted Ordinance AFPD 010, following a public hearing on the matter, held on October 20, 2020, adopting the 2019 California Fire Code, Title 24, California Code of Regulations, Part 9 (Code), including appendices, save and except such portions as deleted, modified or amended; and

WHEREAS, The California Health and Safety Code allows for amendments reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geographical or topographical conditions; and

WHEREAS, The District finds it necessary, based on express findings of these local conditions, to amend the Code to provide additional fire measures in an attempt to reduce the severity of fire and potential loss of life and property; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 13869.7(c), this Ordinance AFPD 010 shall not become effective until ratification by the County of Amador (County); and

WHEREAS, Upon ratification, the County shall file a copy of this Ordinance AFPD 010, which includes the required findings of the District, with the California Department of Housing and Community Development.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador that said Board does hereby ratify Ordinance AFPD 010 and the County shall file a copy of this finding with the California Department of Housing and Community Development.
