WHEREAS, Rick and Valerie have watched the business grow over the years, with clay mining being one of the main services of the company. Kreth, Inc. has been contracted by Pacific Coast Building Products out of Lincoln for 29 years; and

WHEREAS, Kreth, Inc. continues to be a family business, with Thelma still involved, as well as Valerie and their daughter Andrea working in the office. During the busy summer season, the company employs nearly 30 workers, then scales back to around a dozen in the winter months; and

WHEREAS, Rick is the past and present President of the Ione Business and Community Association; past President and past Treasurer of the Ione Rotary, and he served on the Amador Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors. He currently serves on the Board of Directors of the Amador County Economic Development Corp.
