WHEREAS, pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4672.2, the County of Amador is to be reimbursed for its actual and reasonable costs incurred in giving notice of the sale of tax-defaulted property; and,

WHEREAS, it appearing that the sum of \$790.00 is an amount not exceeding the average cost of identifying, through title search, the persons and entities entitled to notice of sale of tax-defaulted property, plus the actual cost of mailing, by certified mail, the required notices to such persons and entities;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador that, pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4672.2, the Amador County Tax Collector is authorized to collect the sum of \$790.00 per sale parcel, as reimbursement to the County for the cost of giving notice of tax sales to parties of interest, as required by Law.
