WHEREAS, Karl Knobelauch was born in Omaha, Nebraska and came with his family to the San Francisco Bay Area at age 11; and

WHEREAS, Karl attended Sacramento State College where he met Patty, then worked as a police dispatcher with the Novato Police Department at age 19. At age 21 he became a Novato Police Officer and spent the next ten years as a Police Officer and later Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, Karl and Patty married in 1974 and lived in Marin and Sonoma Counties until 1981 when they moved to Patty's family's ranch in the Ione Valley and built a house on the ranch and he transferred to the Amador County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, Karl spent the next 25 years advancing from Deputy Sheriff, Sergeant, Commander and retired as Undersheriff after a 37 year career; and

WHEREAS, Karl came out of retirement for two years when he was appointed Director of Human Resources by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, then retired again; and

WHEREAS, Karl has volunteered his time on many Boards including Sutter Amador Hospital Trustee, Amador County Unified School District / Amador County Office of Education Trustee, Amador County Chamber of Commerce, and Amador Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Karl currently serves as President of the Preston Castle Foundation and is a Member of the Board and Executive Committee of the Amador Council of Tourism.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, does hereby recognize Karl Knobelauch as Recipient of the 2018 Margaret Dalton Golden Acorn Award.
