MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT (MHSA)
THREE YEAR REVERSION EXPENDITURE
PLAN FOR FISCAL YEARS 2017 - 2020

RESOLUTION NO. 18-047

WHEREAS, in 2004, California voters passed proposition 63, the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), which became law on January 1, 2005. The act imposes 1% taxation on personal income exceeding \$1 million; and

WHEREAS, over the past 10 years, these funds have transformed, expanded and enhanced the current mental health system. MHSA has allowed Amador County Behavioral Health Services (ACBHS) to significantly improve services and increase access for previous underserved groups through the creation of community based services and supports, prevention and early intervention programs, workforce, education and training, as well as innovative, new approaches to providing programs to the public; and

WHEREAS, with the passage of Assembly Bill (AB114), counties received notification that previously unspent MHSA funds have been reallocated back to the counties and components in which they originated; and

WHEREAS, Amador County Behavioral Health Services received notification from the State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) that funds from the Community Services and Supports, Prevention and Early Intervention and Innovations components have been reallocated to the county; and

WHEREAS, the MHSA Three-year Reversion Expenditure Plan for fiscal years 2017-18 through 2019-20 was circulated to representatives of stakeholder interests and any interested party for 30 days for review and comment and a public hearing was held by the local Behavioral Health Advisory Board on April 18, 2018. No public comment on this plan was received.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Amador County Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the MHSA Three-year Reversion Expenditure Plan for fiscal years 2017-18 through 2019-20.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 22nd day of May 2018, by the following vote:
