WHEREAS, Jim has been a fixture on local radio in Amador County going on 42 years, starting with KNGT (K-Nugget) in 1976 and continuing today on KVGC Radio, AM & FM stations, with a detour in 2003 when Jim and his wife, Teresa, had to look for a way to keep local radio going, and they started HomeTown Radio broadcasting on the SCA (sideband) channel of 94.3.; and

WHEREAS, Jim has served in organizations such as Jackson Lions, Amador Little League, and Amador Fair Foundation, and coaching football for Argonaut High School. Jim has also served on the Amador County Chamber of Commerce and the Chamber Executive Committee Board of Directors. Jim was the founding Chair of the Chamber of Commerce Trade Show and Business Expo held at the Jackson Rancheria; and

WHEREAS, all of Jim's volunteer work pales in comparison to "A Christmas to Remember," the annual two-day "fundraiser of the airwaves" held by the Christmas to Remember Foundation, which has collected over \$1,500,000 in donations for children's winter clothing since its inception in the 1990s; and

WHEREAS, Jim was named Amador County Citizen of the Year in 2001, received the Amador County Chamber of Commerce Margaret Dalton Golden Nugget award in 2006, and the Red Cross "Good Samaritan" for the Greater Mother Lode Region in 2017; and

WHEREAS, Jim and Teresa live in Jackson and have three sons; two of them, JD and Jake, currently work for KVGC. Their youngest son, Joey, is in his fourth year at University of the Pacific and is a communication/business major with plans to join the family business upon graduation.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California that said Board does hereby recognize Jim Guidi as Recipient of the 2018 Amador County Chamber of Commerce Business Person of the Year Award.
