WHEREAS, Laurie graduated from El Segundo High School, and attended UC Davis and UC Berkeley before graduating in 1970 from UC San Francisco Medical School of Nursing with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Science; and

WHEREAS, Laurie married her high school sweetheart, Howard Webb in 1970; and

WHEREAS, Laurie worked in a variety of psychiatric hospitals in the Bay Area as a nurse until 1973, when her daughter, Alex, was born; and

WHEREAS, Laurie and her family bought property in Sutter Creek in 1980 and moved to Amador County, where she went to work as a nurse at Kit Carson as well as working weekends for the home health agency and after hours as a crisis worker for Amador County Mental Health; and

WHEREAS, Laurie served on the Sutter Amador Hospital Board of Directors for 10 years and is currently serving on the Foothill Conservancy Board, the Sutter Amador Community Advisory Council, and has served for 25 years on the Amador-Tuolumne Community Action Agency Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Laurie has also spent the last 25 years as Director of the Amador Senior Center, where her efforts have met the challenge of many changes in activities and services needed for a growing senior population, and have been rewarded with the excellent support the Center has received from individuals and organizations in Amador County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, does hereby recognize Laurie Webb as Recipient of the 2017 Margaret Dalton Golden Acorn Award.
