RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RATE  
INCREASE REQUEST FOR SOLID WASTE  
COLLECTION IN FRANCHISE AREA 1

RESOLUTION NO. 17-094

WHEREAS, the County of Amador (“County”) has granted to ACES Waste Services, Inc. (“ACES”) a franchise to collect solid waste in portions of the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the franchise agreement the rates and charges imposed by ACES for collection of solid waste shall be set from time to time by resolution of the County’s Board of Supervisors after public notice and public hearing; and

WHEREAS, ACES has requested a rate increase for solid waste collection in Franchise Area 1 as describe on Attachment A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the County, in compliance with California Proposition 218, has provided specific notice to property owners/customers within Franchise Area 1 of the proposed increase and advised them of the opportunity to file a protest against the proposed fee increase; and

WHEREAS, out of the approximately 950 customers notified, the County received no written protests; and

WHEREAS, the proposed increase in rates for solid waste collection was reviewed, taking into account ACES’ service to customers, performance of other duties required by franchise agreement, profitability, administrative costs, operational costs, capital costs, and other appropriate financial matters, and was found to be justifiable; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California that said Board does hereby approve the rate increase request for solid waste collection in Franchise Area 1. The new rate schedule set forth in Attachment A shall be effective September 1, 2017 for garbage collection rates in Franchise Area 1.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 22nd day of August 2017 by the following vote:
