WHEREAS, Michael Parks was born December 10, 1976 in Irvine, CA to Laurence and Pamela Parks; and

WHEREAS, Michael graduated from Galt High School in 1995 and enlisted in the Marine Corps where he attained the rank of Corporal assigned to the duty of Security Battalion as well as battalion Primary Marksmanship Instructor at Camp Pendleton, then was honorably discharged in January 2001; and

WHEREAS, Michael graduated from the Palomar Police Academy in 2000 and was hired by the Amador County Sheriff's Office on April 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Michael's career has included being a member of the Marijuana Suppression Unit until it was disbanded, member of the SWAT team and is currently Assistant Team Leader, Field Training Officer, assigned as an Agent to ACCNET, promoted to Sergeant in 2010; and

WHEREAS, Michael is currently serving as Task Force Supervisor to ACCNET and is responsible for hundreds of arrests and the eradication of 20 clandestine drug labs, plus the seizure of at least \$750,000.00 in drug related cash and assets, as well as assisting in the detection, investigation and eradication of no less than 200 illegal marijuana cultivations; and

WHEREAS, he has testified as expert witness in court, provided training to various county entities, and instructed Argonaut High School students in topics related to narcotics abuse, and has spoken to numerous community organizations and groups.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby honor and commend Michael Lee Parks upon being selected as the Amador County Peace Officers' Association 2017 Peace Officer of the Year.
