WHEREAS, Eric graduated from Amador High School in 1984. Eric worked in the logging industry and attended Sacramento City College graduating with an Associate Degree in 1987; and

WHEREAS, in 1990 Eric began his law enforcement career with the Amador County Sheriff's Office as a Sheriff's Dispatcher; and

WHEREAS, in 1991 Eric was selected as the Dispatcher of the Year for Amador County; and

WHEREAS, in 1991 through 1992 Eric attended the San Joaquin Delta College POST Academy; and

WHEREAS, in 1992 Eric was hired as deputy sheriff for the Amador County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, from 1992 to 2017 Eric was assigned to the Patrol Bureau, where in addition to regular patrol duties, he also worked assignments as the East Bay Municipal Utilities District Deputy and as an Evidence Technician; and

WHEREAS, Eric's personnel file boasts many commendations from citizens, public safety partners and supervisory staff, and during Eric's 27 year tenure at the Amador County Sheriff's Office he never received a single citizen complaint; and

WHEREAS, Eric is the proud father of 26 year old Amanda Larson and 20 year old Nathan Larson, and is happily married to Leah Larson.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby adopt this resolution commending Eric Larson for his 27 years of service to the people of Amador County.
