WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal Admin. Code § 18730, which contains the terms of a standard model Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which will be amended to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, Government Code § 11370, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, this body has determined that the attached Conflict of Interest Code and its Appendices of Designated Employees and Disclosure Categories accurately set forth those positions which should be designated and the categories of financial interests which should be made reportable.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board of Supervisors does hereby approve and adopt the attached amended Conflict of Interest Code and Appendices of Employees and Disclosure Categories for the following officials, departments and agencies: Board of Supervisors; County Counsel's Office; Administrative Office; Administration; Human Resources, Information Technology, Risk Management; Community Development; Building Department, Planning Department, Environmental Health, Land Use, Public Works, Surveying and Engineering; Health & Human Services; Public Administrator/Guardian/Conservator, Behavioral Health Care Division; General Services Administration; Public Services; Agriculture/Weights and Measures; Air Pollution; Probation; Assessor's Office; Auditor/Controller; Clerk/Recorder; District Attorney's Office; Sheriff/Coroner's Office; Treasurer/Tax Collector; Code Enforcement: Elections Department: Office of Emergency Services.
